Along with the application, the following additional information is required:

- 1. A Personal Artist Statement about how your work connects the viewer to the Natural World and how you yourself personally connect with Priscilla Hathaway's core values.
- 2. A Professional letter of reference (teacher or guidance counselor)
- 3. A Character letter of reference from an employer, scout or community leader and or neighbor.
- 4. An official school transcript including credits and class rank.

Applicants will be assessed according to their personal artist statement and a submission of a piece of visual art such as a drawing, painting, or art installation, with 2D or 3D.

No video or animation will be accepted.

Art work should be photographed and sent digitally with the application.

The original piece of work should be submitted to Kate Butler, ORRHS art teacher.

Preference will be given to Mattapoisett residents attending, ORRHS, Marion Road, Mattapoisett 02739 and graduating by June 2024.

The deadline for submitting the forms will be April 22, 2024. The recipient will be notified by mail by May 15, 2024 and will be recognized at the school's awards ceremony, on May 30, 2024.

\*Once the candidate is chosen their artwork must be matted or mounted for display.

The actual award will be disbursed after the student submits an official college transcript documenting a successful completion of his or her first semester in college to:
